The final exam will count 10% of the final grade.

Tests/Quizzes – You will be informed of a test at least two days in advance. If you are absent the day before a test, but are present the day of the test, you are required to take the test. If you are absent the day of the test, the test must be made up within two days. Please be at school no later than 8:15AM Eastern to make up the test or quiz. Problems on a test without valid work receive **no credit** even if the answer is correct. When in doubt, show your work. This policy also pertains to assignments and quizzes.

Homework – I rarely assign homework. The only homework you will have is incomplete classwork. If any class time is allotted to work on the assignment then no student may “save” the assignment to work on at home. Failure to be on task will result in a detention.

Notebook – Your notebook is very important in this class. Please purchase a three-ring binder and dividers. The dividers should be as follows:

Warm-ups – A warm-up will be given on a daily basis. You are required to write the problem and show all work to receive a correct answer. We will go over the warm-up daily in class. You will be given a calendar in order to keep up with your warm-ups. Once the calendar is full, it will be taken up for a classwork or quiz grade.

Classroom Rules

1. All cellphones are to be placed in the phone pocket hanging by the door as soon as you walk in the classroom. NO EXCEPTIONS. Lying about your phone and/or having it out in class will result in an automatic referral.
2. No eating in this classroom.
3. Respect others; keep hands, feet, insults, and other objects to yourself.
4. The student is not to talk without the teacher's permission.
5. The student is to stay in his/her assigned seat. You are not to move seats unless told to do so.
6. No grooming or sleeping.
7. Do not work on any other subject during class unless given permission to do so.
8. Appropriate language will be used.
9. Students are to stay on task when using technology. This includes cellphones, tablets, chrome books, laptops, etc. No venturing off to other websites/applications not relevant to the assignment.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION:

3. Third offense – Referral to office

****A severe behavioral offense will result in an immediate office referral.**

Entering the Classroom

Students should be in their seats when the tardy bell rings. Everyone should start on the warm-up assignment. It will be located on the board or screen. Sit in your assigned seat quietly until class is started. NO WALKING AROUND THE ROOM.

Leaving the Classroom

Students may not pack up to leave until instructed to do so. Please understand the bell does not dismiss you. You will only be dismissed when EVERYONE is seated and quiet. DO NOT CROWD MY DOOR.

Make-up Work –If you are absent it is your responsibility to find out what work you missed. Check Google Classroom for make-up work. I will continue to post video lectures and assignments on my Google Classroom every day for those students that are absent with an excuse. Turn in make-up work to the make-up work box. Students with excused absences may make-up work. Students can make up tests or quizzes at 8:15AM Eastern. Check with Mrs. Boleware for an available morning to make up tests or quizzes. Any work not made up within three days will receive a grade of a zero.

Tardy to Class – Students that enter the classroom after I admit them will be considered late and marked tardy for that day.

Bathroom Passes – Each student will receive 10 bathroom passes per nine weeks. Any passes that are not used throughout the nine weeks will result in 1 bonus point per pass on any test or quiz. When all bathroom passes have been used, the student will receive a tardy for each time he/she needs to use the bathroom during class.

Supplies – Students are expected to come to class with their supplies. Students must have the following supplies on a daily basis: notebook, pencil, assignments, and a scientific calculator. A student will be assigned disciplinary action for not having the supplies on a daily basis.

Late Work – I do not accept late work unless it is due to an absence.

Cell Phones – All cell phones will be placed in the phone pocket at the front of the room. Failure to place your phone in the phone pocket will result in an immediate office referral. Having a cellphone out in class for any reason will result in the phone being taken and an immediate office referral. The only exception is if the teacher allows the student to have their phone.

Extra Help – I will be here before school at 8:15 Eastern in the mornings for students needing extra help, make up work, and detentions. I will only be available by appointment. Please ask at least the day before help is needed.

Calculator - *It is imperative that you purchase a scientific calculator for this class. You will not be successful without a calculator. Please purchase the scientific calculator TI-30X IIS. You will be required to bring a calculator every day to this class. A cell phone CANNOT be used in place of a calculator.*
