



COVID-19 Isolation and Quarantine changes

The guidelines of COVID-19 isolation and quarantine for Lee County Schools are as follows:

- If a student or staff member test positive for COVID, they will be required to quarantine at home for **5 days**. After day 5, the student/staff member may return to school/work, **but** they **must** wear a well-fitting face mask for **days 6-10**. If the student/staff member refuses to wear a mask for 5 days, they will be required to stay out for the full 10 days and quarantine at home.
- We will **no longer** send home the close contact letter to the class. **THIS IS CHANGING FROM HOW WE HAVE PREVIOUSLY HANDLED THIS SITUATION.**
- If there is positive person in the home, the close contact (student or staff member) may return to school/work, **but** they **must** wear a well-fitting face mask for **10 days**. **THIS IS CHANGING FROM HOW WE HAVE PREVIOUSLY HANDLED THIS SITUATION.**
- If a student or staff member has doctor's orders to quarantine for 10 days, we will not shorten the doctor's recommendation.
