- 4. Printed copies of any EDUCATIONAL PLAN identified in Section A.
- Printed copies of all registration and enrollment documents as outlined in Lee County Board of Education Policy.

6.1.5. Admission/Enrollment Requirements a. Required Documentation - Students entering the school system for the first time, regardless of grade level, are not required to submit a birth certificate, but may be requested to submit a birth certificate or another form of acceptable documentation to verify the student's age. A social security number may also be requested, but such request is voluntary and is not a requirement of enrollment. b. Other Registration Materials. In addition, students may also be required to submit other registration materials as school officials may reasonably require including, but not limited to, a certificate of immunization or an exemption as prescribed by the Department of Public Health and signed by a private physician or appropriate health department official. The Superintendent may accept alternate forms of evidence or modify otherwise applicable requirements as necessary and appropriate to accommodate children in foster care and migrant, immigrant, limited English proficient or homeless students. Students shall also present two (2) proofs of residency (copy of utility bill, telephone bill, rent receipt, etc.) of the parent(s), legal custodians, and/or legal guardians; c. Grade Placement. The school principal shall determine grade placement of students from a private or nonpublic school or from home education based on state regulations and Lee County Board of Education rules regarding transfer of credit as well as other factors including test data, age, and previous school records.
